Argus Singers: COVID19 Guidance for members

1. Members' responsibility

1.1 Before a rehearsal

- 1. Do not come to rehearsal if:
 - you have symptoms / feel unwell
 - you have tested positive with either a PCR or Lateral flow test
 - you have been told to self-isolate
 - · someone you have close contact with has tested positive
 - you are quarantining after a visit abroad.
- 2. We encourage you to take a lateral flow test on the day of rehearsal if you can (*but we will not ask if you have done so*).
 - Lateral flow test are freely available from pharmacies, just ask for them
 - Or they can be ordered online from www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests.
- 3. On entering the building
 - check in using the venue's test and trace procedures
 - sanitise your hands, maintain social distancing and wear a mask until you reach your seat.
- 4. Let us take your temperature using a "no touch" thermometer before you enter the rehearsal room, if it is high you will be asked to leave.

1.2 During rehearsal

- 1. Take a seat in your section: please do not move chairs.
- 2. Observe 1m social distancing at all times.
- 3. Wear a face mask when not rehearsing.
- 4. Consider bringing warm clothing as we will keep doors/windows open for ventilation where practical.
- 5. Bring your own music: do not share.
- 6. Bring your own refreshments and take these away afterwards.
- 7. Avoid touching shared surfaces as much as possible: sanitise your hands after doing so.

1.3 After rehearsal

- 1. At the end of the rehearsal please leave your chair where it is.
- Maintain social distancing whilst leaving the building by either stairs of lift.
 - The lift should be used by only one person at a time:
 - anyone waiting to use the lift is asked to remain in the rehearsal room until it is available.
- 3. If you test positive after a rehearsal contact the membership secretary: do not return to rehearsals until your quarantine period has ended and you have the "all clear".

2. Committee's responsibility

2.1 Before rehearsal

- 1. The venue, chairs and piano will be cleaned before our rehearsal: The piano will be surrounded by perspex screens to protect the accompanist.
- 2. Chairs and the piano will be placed at suitable positions, chairs 1m apart from each other.
- 3. We will take members' temperatures and ask anyone with a high reading to leave.

2.2 During rehearsal

- 1. The Membership Secretary will take an attendance register each rehearsal.
- 2. The piano will be surrounded by perspex screens to protect the accompanist.

2.3 After rehearsal

- 1. The venue, chairs and piano will be cleaned after use and put away by committee members.
- 2. If anyone contacts the membership secretary about testing positive after a rehearsal she will inform all all other attendees.
